

Century +70!

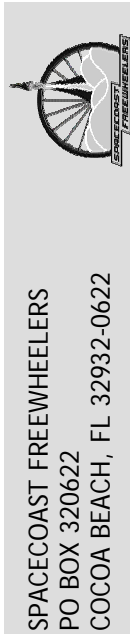

There will be only unmanned SAG stops with Gatorade and water, riders will have to make use of convenience stores along the route and our drop site. We'll mark the route for you and try to make your ride as convenient as possible.

Packet pickup and check in will be at the Doubletree Hotel located at 2080 N Atlantic Ave, Cocoa Beach, FL from 1:00pm until 5:00pm on Saturday (March 31) and at the start line beginning at 6:00am on Sunday (April 1). There will be NO registration available on the day of the ride.

Your entry includes the League of American Bicyclists (LAB) insurance fee. Therefore all participants are required to sign the standard LAB liability insurance waiver while checking in. Due to this requirement each participant must pick up his/her own packet. Helmets ARE required. Participants under 18 years of age must be accompanied by an adult cyclist at all times and have a liability release form signed by a parent or guardian.

Mass start is at 7:00am on Sunday, April 1, 2011 from Alan Shepard Park in Cocoa Beach, FL. Ride ends at Linda Pederson Park near Weeki Wachee, FL with a catered BBQ dinner.

All SAG support will end at 7:50pm, if you are unable to finish before then you must be SAG'ed to the finish.
